#### Field Trip & Outreach Policies

Proof of bus reservation is required *within 30 days* of scheduled field trip. Reservations should be made *at least 6* weeks in advance. Museum memberships do not apply to field trips. There is a \$100 cancellation/no-show fee.

Hours: Field trips can be booked from 9:30am-3:00pm Monday-Friday. Outreaches can be scheduled Monday-Sunday at mutually agreed upon times.

Field Trip Size: Maximum field trip size is 70 students. Accommodations for larger groups will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

**Custom Themes:** Customize theme for an additional fee. Please inquire at time of reservation.

Field Trip Chaperones: For every five students, one adult chaperone is required. Chaperones must be 18 years or older and must remain with the students at all time. A \$20 fee will be charged if the minimum number of chaperones is not present.

## **Enterprise Zone Tax Credit**

EUREKA! is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. All gifts to EUREKA! are tax-deductible to the fullest extent possible! Not only may donors deduct their gifts from both federal and state returns, they also may be able to claim the additional Enterprise Zone tax credit on their State of Colorado return. This means that depending upon a donor's tax bracket and itemizations, a donation may cost the donor less than the amount of the contribution.

Cash donations of \$100 or more may be eligible for a 25% tax credit on donor's Colorado State Income Tax Return. In-kind gifts valued at \$100 or above may be eligible for a 12.5% tax credit on donor's Colorado State Tax Return. In-kind donations of \$2,000 or more must be accompanied by valuation documentation.

## **YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The EUREKA! McConnell Science Museum aims to bring "science into the hands of kids". The Youth Scholarship Program is designed for those students who need financial assistance to participate in EUREKA! science programs.

## **Application Process**

- Applications will be accepted up until two weeks prior to the camp start date
- Applications must be signed by parent/guardian of the applicant
- Applications must be complete in order to be considered

## Eligibility

- Applicants must be under 18 years of age
- Applicants must provide a current Free/Reduced School Lunch approval letter from the School District OR a copy of current Medicaid, Marillac Clinic, or CHP+ cards
- Applicants must provide a new application for each camp

## **Scholarship Review & Award Process**

Applications will be reviewed by EUREKA! staff upon receipt to determine eligibility. Approved applicants will be awarded a 75% scholarship. Please note that scholarship funds are limited. If funds are depleted, scholarship applications will be placed on hold until further funding is received. Scholarships are available for youth science day camps, after school programs, preschool programs, and Leadership Camps. EUREKA! Expeditions in the Environmental Institute for Stewardship & Leadership are eligible for a reduced scholarship. Applicants will be limited to three (3) scholarships per calendar year.

## **Registration Process**

Applicants will be notified of scholarship award and registration process via email. Camp registration will be the responsibility of the applicant. Scholarship approval does not automatically register the applicant for the program.
